




"As a paper engineer, my work is rooted in print media, book arts and commercial design. Beginning with an intital fold, a single action causes a transfer of energy to subsequent folds, which ultimatley manifest in drawing and three dimensional forms. I use my engineering skills to create kinetic sculptures which have led to collaborations with scientists at University of Michigan. We work on the nonscale, translating paper structures to micro folds. Our investigations extend to visualizing cellular dicision and solar cell development. Researchers see paper engineering as a metaphor for scientific principles; I see their inquiry as a basis for artistic inspiration. In my studio I am a collaborator, explorer and innovator. I begin with a system of folding and at a particular moment the material takes over. Guided by wonder, my owrk is made because I cannot visualise its final realization; in this way I come to understanding through curiosity"


Unholy 111 When you let go you win, 2018, paper, 60 x 48 x 4 inches

Omoplata 35 Dagger moths in red, paper, 22 x 22 x 2 inches




Omoplata 56, 2021, paper, 26 x 22 x 2 inches







Ara 314 Such a thirst I had, 2017, paper, 60 x 60 x 5 inches





Unholy 75, 2017, paper, 57 x 52 x 6 inches





Unholy 124, 2018, paper, 48 x 48 x 3 inches












Omoplata 44 in turqouise, 2020, paper, 22 x 22 x 1 inches




Omoplata 40 in turqoise, 2020, paper, 18 x 18 x 1 inches




6, 2008, ballpoint pen on paper, 25 x 19 inches




Drift, 2009, ballpoint pen on paper, 19 x 25 inches




Ara 446 Some caterpillars stay caterpillars, paper, 25 x 25 x 1 inches



Ara 446 Some caterpillars are black and white, paper,  $25 \times 25 \times 1$  inches




Omoplata 45, 2021, celadon iridescent paper, 12 x 12 x 1 inches





Omoplata 46, 2021, celadon iridescent paper, 12 x 12 x 1 inches


Unholy 261, gold iridescent paper, 48 x 68 x 3 inches














Ara 251 in indigo, paper, 18 x 18 x 1 inches
